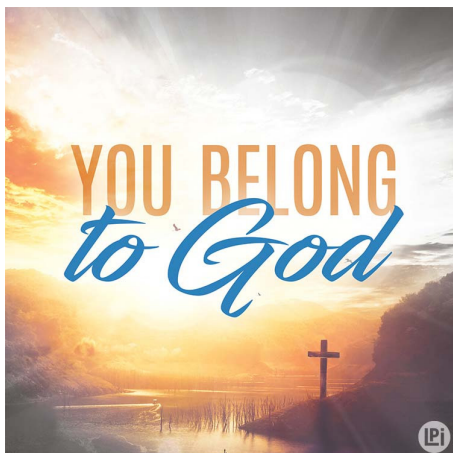

Flowers at the Altar this weekend are in Honor of Duke & Mary Dorge 62nd Wedding Anniversary

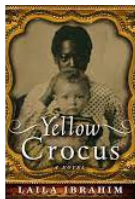
We pray for the repose of the soul of our brother in Christ, Joseph Schutzenhofer who passed away Friday, July 2nd.

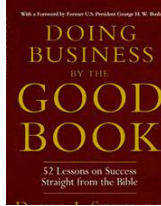

NOTES FROM VICKI

Dear Families and Friends of PSR!

The upcoming PSR Program is not going to look exactly like it has in the past, but I am finding that necessary changes are bringing numerous blessings! As you know, we are chronically short of space and classrooms for instruction of any type, so I am rearranging things a bit. As soon as we all get a chance to settle in with Fr Medina I will give you more details, but in the meantime I want to focus on Second Grade and First Communion Preparation. First of all, Mrs Wolf will still be the lead catechist, God love her!! There are no human words for her devotion and dedication to your children during this most important Sacrament, so God will surely reward her in Heaven! Thank you, Joan! The big change will be the time and location for Second Grade/First Communion, which will be from 9:00 am to 10:00 am (between 8:00 am and 10:00 am Masses), with families meeting after class to sit together at Mass. Many times, Mrs. Wolf brings her class into the church because students are not able to regularly make it to Mass. There is a good deal of instruction that takes place within the church and the classroom. This will give families a solid reference for conversation and church teachings at home. Let's face it...everyone, including me, has limited knowledge of what Catholicism really is so please look forward to this change as an opportunity to grow in your parenting and as a Catholic! Sharing that with your children is absolutely priceless! Becoming closer to God as a family is rewarded with everlasting life together!

Each week throughout the summer will focus on one or two grades and the curriculum overviews, with any location or time changes included long before PSR begins in September.

I always begin any process of change slowly, and I will show you the research I use to bring about a more family oriented PSR program. First and foremost, I consult the Catechism of the Catholic Church reference book. We have several in the library and I have two copies if you want to see it. Every Catholic home should have one! This is the reference on parents as educators:

“ . . . The home is the first school of Christian life and ‘a school for human enrichment.’ Here one learns endurance and the joy of work, fraternal love, generous — even repeated — forgiveness, and above all divine worship in prayer and the offering of one’s life.” – Catechism of the Catholic Church 1657

The following information is a beginning checklist used by most Education Directors as a preparation for their parents with children who will be in second grade this fall. It is also a handy guide to keep around.

This page is the first in a series about preparation for First Penance, which must be completed before the First Holy Communion is received, with the goal of letting parents understand and take a more active role in the process.

How Can I Help Prepare My Child for First Penance?

1. **LOVE AND FORGIVE YOUR CHILD.** For years you have been preparing your child for Penance by showing your love and forgiveness in the home. Knowing what it is like to forgive and to be forgiven in the family situation is a vital element of preparation for First Penance.

2. **PRAY WITH YOUR CHILD.** Pray both formally and informally with your child, allowing and encouraging the child to use his or her own words. Include a petition for forgiveness in the family's evening prayers.

3. **TEACH YOUR CHILD.** To relieve anxiety, it is best that your child is totally prepared for the logistics of reception of the Sacrament. It is also of great assistance to the teachers if you regularly review with your child the Act of Contrition, the Ten Commandments, and an examination of conscience.

4. **GIVE YOUR CHILD AN EXAMPLE TO FOLLOW.** Take the child with you when you receive the Sacrament. Show the child that you readily and joyfully receive this gift of forgiveness from the Lord. Do not pass on to the child any of your doubts, scruples, or fears.

5. **ENGENDER TRUST IN THE PRIEST.** Assure your child that the priest will not repeat anything that is said in confession, and that he is understanding and is concerned with helping them become better.

6. **SUPPORT THE SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION PROGRAM AND THE TEACHERS.** Your child's consistent attendance at class is, of course, of primary importance. In addition, check his or her homework, talk to the teachers, and keep abreast of where he or she is in the preparation process.

7. **HOW MUCH DO I CARE?** There is a danger that preparation for Penance could become merely “the right thing to do.” But preparing a child for Penance calls for real caring and prayer. How much do I want my child to repent, to reconcile, to turn his or her life to God? How well am I conveying to him or her the forgiveness of God in his or her daily life? How much do I listen to my child? How much do I pray for my child?
