


Our Lady of the Lake Parish is supporting the Hope House with school supplies for students returning to school within our Community. The following items can be dropped off at the Church entrances:



Sign Up this Weekend in Fellowship Hall for the Queenship of Mary Novena

On Sunday, August 22, 2021 we will once again celebrate our chosen patronal feast day, the Feast of the Queenship of Mary, and solemn celebration of our patroness, Mary, the Mother of God and Queen of heaven and earth.

To prepare for our patronal feast, which will be celebrated the weekend of August 22, 2021, we will hold a novena of prayer each night beginning Friday, August 13 through Saturday, August 21 consisting of scripture, songs, and the praying of the rosary and of the Litany of Loretto in front of an altar set up with our traveling statue of the Blessed Virgin. People attending may bring flowers or candles to decorate the altar. After the prayer, a simple meal will be shared with those who attend.
