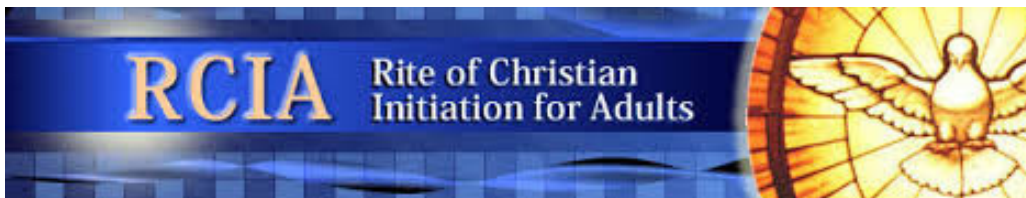
PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION
