Psalm 91 is called the Soldier's Psalm since it was told that in World War I, many soldiers recited this Psalm daily. Why? It is a prayer of inspiration for safety and protection. Not only for those in our military service that are supporting and defending the Constitution of the United States but also for those that may need physical/spiritual support.

Psalm 91

He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High

will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare

and from the deadly pestilence.

He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge;

his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness,

nor the plague that destroys at midday.

A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.

For he will command his angels concerning you

to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.

I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name.

He will call upon me, and I will answer him;
