From the Pastor's Desk: 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

I have a lot of stuff, but do I have a lot of God? Since my move to this parish, I came to see with my own eyes, and sore back, that I have accumulated a lot of stuff. Now, am I able to say the same thing about my relationship with God? Each day, God willingly and unselfishly gives us an abundance of gifts, yet we seek earthly wealth and riches, things we believe will give us satisfaction.
