From the Pastor's Desk:

Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Beatitudes (Matthew 5: 1-12a) teach us how to live properly. We cannot be proud or arrogant or rely on the riches and power of the world. We must be obedient to what God wills of us in order to enjoy the fullness of life in heaven. Those who desire to stand out in the crowd, doing their own thing or doing it their way, is not fulfilling what God desires of them. We are to place our entire being in trust and confidence of God rather than clinging to the ways of the world for personal gain and recognition. Let us observe God's laws in humility and not pride ourselves in seeking worldly recognition or personal attention getting.

World Day for Consecrated Life will be celebrated in the universal Church on Thursday, February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, and will be observed in parishes over the weekend of February 4th and 5th. Please pray for all those who have made commitments in the consecrated life, and be sure to thank them on their special day. May they continue to be inspired by Jesus Christ and respond generously to God's gift of their vocation.

As I mentioned last week, the World Day of Prayer for the Sick will be observed in our parish at the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday February 12th with the Communal Anointing of the Sick taking place during this Mass. Those who wish to receive this sacrament will be seated in the front of church (the Knights of Columbus will assist individuals for the reception of the anointing to the reserved area). To receive the sacrament one must be elderly, preparing for a serious surgery, or have a significant physical or mental malady. If you have any questions about receiving this sacrament you may call me at the Parish Office.

A reminder to join me in supporting this year's Catholic Stewardship Appeal. Our parish goal is \$32,252.00 with commitments of \$20,783.00 and received total of \$17,483.00. The diocesan goal is \$1,100,000.00. After the diocesan goal has been met, any parish meeting their individual goal is eligible to receive a rebate of 10% of the goal, plus 90% of any funds raised above the goal. Parish goals must be met with cash and/or pledges received by March 15th and fulfilled by the fiscal year ending June 30th. ~ Fr. Penn





Grateful Living: The Joy of Stewardship

We want to take a minute to Thank You for the interest so many of you have displayed in the last week about our upcoming Small Groups. Thank You to those that have volunteered to host small groups, those who have reached out with questions to better understand the purpose and value of small groups, and those who inquired about what the common theme of this year's small groups will be. We thought we would share the 4 most asked questions and inquiries with everyone.

1. **What is this year's small group common theme?** This year's small groups will be focused on a faith-sharing resource that deepens our understanding of the Church's mission and vision of stewardship. More detail on the back of this page and available at the workshop we have scheduled for those interested in hosting a small group.
2. **What do you mean by stewardship? Isn't that a focus on financial contributions to the church?** Being good stewards of the gifts God has given us goes far beyond just the financial contributions we make to the church. We believe the meaning of stewardship is best explained on our Diocese Website and we encourage everyone to visit this information at: <https://diojeffcity.org/stewardship/>
 - A short answer for the meaning of stewardship is best described by our Diocese website: "What is Stewardship: What identifies a steward? Safeguarding material and human resources and using them responsibly, **generous giving of time, talent, and treasure.**"
 - Our Grateful Living study guide also reminds us in the foreword of the book: "Stewardship means being welcoming to all people, inside and outside the parish; making prayer a central experience of everyday life; inviting others to prayer and worship; continuously forming knowledge and understanding of the Gospel; and contributing our gifts, talents, and skills to service the common good at home, in the church, and in the world at large."
3. **When is the last day to sign-up to host a small group?** We are hosting a workshop for anyone that has signed up or is thinking about signing up to host a small group. Please see the schedule for workshops below. If you have signed up to host a small group or are interested in hosting, join us for any one of the workshops. Only one workshop is required.
4. **I'm not interested in hosting a small group. When can I join a small group? What happens if I can't attend all 6 small group sessions during lent?** We will be having small group sign-up after Masses on February 4th and 5th. Or you can contact us individually and we will help you get connected with a small group. If you can't make all 6 sessions of your small group, talk with your small group host and they will help you through how to have a meaningful experience in a small group, even if you miss a session.

A twelve-session, faith-sharing resource to communicate the Church's mission and vision of stewardship using the small group faith-sharing model.

6 Weeks through Lent (Feb. 19 – April 1) - Season One Faith Sharing:

Acknowledging God's Gifts and Hearing God's Call

All we have—our lives; our talents, skills, and resources; the world around us—are free gifts from God. We show our gratitude for these gifts by giving them back through acts of generosity and hospitality, supporting and caring for the Church, the earth, our communities, and each other. This is stewardship.

6 Weeks Fall prior to Advent (Oct. 22 – Dec 9) - Season Two Faith Sharing:

Setting Life Priorities and Making a Commitment

A good steward honestly answers the question, "What do I own, and what owns me"? Stewardship requires us to identify things that keep us from gratefully acknowledging God for all he has given us, putting those things in their proper places, and committing ourselves to lives in which service—to God, the Church, our neighbors, and the earth—is our priority.

Small-Group Leaders, or as we refer to them as, Small-Group Hosts will be invited to a Workshop prior to starting Session One and a Workshop prior to starting Session Two to familiarize the hosts team with the Grateful Living: The Joy of Stewardship materials, meet the coordinating team, and meet other hosts. These workshops will focus on preparations for the session and help each host gain a sense of understanding and support.
