Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time


We are salt...we are light. Jesus desires that as salt and light we never lose our flavor, we never lose our shine. We lose our flavor, we are stale, and if we lose our shine, we cannot penetrate the darkness. Without Jesus and His disciples, the world will become a tasteless and shadowy place. Sin is the principal reason for this and as disciples of Jesus we are called to rise above the world and shine forth the light of Christ and give flavor to the world by sharing His wisdom. As the Responsorial Psalm today reminds us, "The just man is a light in darkness to the upright," may we be just, light, and salt for the world as a faithful and fervent disciple of the Lord.

A reminder that next Sunday at the 10:00 a.m. Mass the Communal Anointing of the Sick will take place. Those who may be anointed are the elderly, those suffering from serious physical or mental illness, and those preparing for serious surgery. If you have any questions regarding participation in the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, do not hesitate to contact me (573) 365-2241. Those wishing to receive the sacrament will be seated in the front of the church. Members of the Knights of Columbus will assist those receiving to the pews.

A reminder regarding CSA: When the diocesan goal (\$1,100,00.00) is met, if our parish meets its goal (\$32,252.00), we will be eligible to receive a rebate of 10% plus 90% of any funds raised above the goal. 

The Diocese of Jefferson City warns the public of what appears to be an ongoing phishing scam involving **TEXTS** and **EMAILS** purportedly from priests or parish/Chancery staff. This scam has hit many parishes across the United States.


The email or text purports to be from a person the target knows, such as one's pastor, a parish staff member, the bishop or someone else from the Church. If the target responds to the fake email or text, the sender will follow up with a request for some sort of monetary assistance, often for gift cards or iTunes cards.

It is truly unfortunate cyber criminals will attempt to exploit the generous nature of our community. Sending emails or texts asking for cash or gifts cards is not how priests, parishes or the Diocese of Jefferson City seeks financial assistance for our work. If you receive an email or text from a trusted church personnel asking for assistance, confirm by calling that person and do NOT respond to the email or text.

- Student must demonstrate a financial need by submitting a copy of their Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Student must submit a letter or recommendation from:
  - 1) School official (teacher, counselor, principal, coach, etc.)
  - 2) Current or present pastor
- For the John L. Warack Scholarship, student must attend University of Missouri–Columbia

### LITURGY CORNER

#### The Psalms: Part 1 –

The psalms are part of the Wisdom Books of the Bible. The Wisdom Books are: Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs, Wisdom & Sirach. The Book of Psalms or The Psalter contains 150 psalms. The number is based on the Hebrew Psalter. We now have 150 psalms, however, some of the longer psalms have been split and shorter psalms combined. Seventy three of the psalms are attributed to David but no sure way exists in dating any psalm.

The psalms were composed for liturgical worship. They follow certain distinct patterns of literary forms. The psalms fall into different categories or themes. These categories are: Praise, Lament, Thanksgiving, Confidence, Kingship and Wisdom. It is important to note that some psalms are from the I/me/my reference (individual), while others are from the we/us/our reference (communal). Next week, we will take a look at other specific aspects of the psalms.
