# From the Pastor's Desk:

Second Sunday of Lent

On Jesus' final journey to Jerusalem that would entail His suffering and death, our Lord was Transfigured before Peter, James, and John, the closest members of the Twelve to Jesus, forty days before this event, to prepare them for the scandal of the Cross. The Lord Jesus was revealed to them in all of His glory, emphasizing that it is only through the Cross, and not avoiding it, that glory was to be lived and experienced. This revelation was not meant to show glory alone, but to encourage Peter, James, John—and us—to not be afraid of the challenges of the world. May the Transfiguration of Jesus be for us that encouragement during this Season of Lent, that the struggles we may encounter will pale in comparison to the glory and victory that awaits us in and through Jesus.

Everyone is invited to attend the Mass of Confirmation on Saturday, March 11th, at 5:00 pm. The Most Reverend W. Shawn McKnight, S.T.D., will be the Principal Celebrant and administer the Sacrament of Confirmation.

On Monday evening, March 20th, a Communal Penance Service for Lent will be held in the church at 7:00 pm. Four priests will be assisting me to give everyone the opportunity for individual Confession and Absolution.

At the Masses the weekend of March 25th and 26th, I will be Commissioning the Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion for ministry to the homebound, infirmed and assistance at Mass. These individuals have received the mandate from Bishop McKnight for service for five years. Congratulations to the members of this parish who have volunteered for this ministry. ~ Fr. Penn







NCYC, for those that have never been, is a wonderful faith filled experience put on every 2 years in Indianapolis. This year’s dates are November 16-18th returning to our parish on Sunday November 19th. The Diocese will be in charge of all transportation to and from and lodging in downtown Indianapolis. We are encouraging all students currently in grades 8-11th to faithfully consider going on this wonderful experience with us.



What do you need to do right now?

- Please get a hold of the parish office or Tony Otto - 573-480-6744 or Sara Barlett - 816-695-6184 and let us know if your student would like to go.
- We ask that each student place a \$100 deposit to go on this trip. The Parish finance committee has agreed to support our students for the remaining balance of the trip. This deposit holds your spot and this information will be provided to the Diocese for transportation and lodging.
- Parents are welcome to join us on our journey to Indianapolis but we ask that the parents pay the full participation rate of \$650.

Tony Otto and Sara Barlett will be joining the students as chaperones for this trip along with any and all parents that would like to go.

We will need to lock in each student and parent that would like to go by March 13th, 2023. Our entry to the Diocese is due on March 15. Please get a hold of one of us and drop a \$100 deposit per student and a \$250 deposit per parent to the office by 3/13/2023.



## VIRTUS SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Today, we are being asked to protect our vulnerable young souls from modern treachery and evil which still exists. As you attend Mass, look at the people in your pew and know that, statistically, 20% of them have been sexually harassed or abused. If it was you, or someone close to you, I am sure you would want to protect both them and yourself. Matthew 10:42 instructs us that giving a cup of cold water to the littlest of His children is the same as giving Christ himself relief in times of trouble.

By completing the VIRTUS Safe Environment Training, we have the means to recognize and stop abuse by being aware of the warning signs. If you find yourself wondering, or your sixth sense is telling you something is amiss, you are NOT ALONE in following through. There is an entire team of folks ready and willing to take your information, anonymously, and see to it that further harm not is allowed.

Many of you have diligently and faithfully completed or updated your 'Protecting Gods Children' or 'VIRTUS' accounts as required by the Church and Jefferson City Diocese. You are to be commended! Thank You!

For those of you who still need the training, or have tried unsuccessfully to complete the training online, the website is often at maximum capacity. Since that is inconvenient and downright frustrating at times, I am scheduling live training sessions the evening of Thursday, March 9th at 6 pm and during the day Tuesday, March 14th at 11 am. Sessions take about 90 minutes, as long as everyone is pre-registered before the session begins. If you are not pre-registered, you may need to take a later class.

1. Make sure you have an email account that you can easily access BEFORE you attempt to set up or update your VIRTUS account.
2. To set up a NEW account go to [virtusonline.org](http://virtusonline.org) and click on the "First Time Registrant" link, then set up your new account with a login ID and password. Follow the prompts to register for TRAINING AT OUR LADY OF THE LAKE PARISH, then select one of the above session dates. You will receive an email verifying that the account has successfully been set up. Your registration for the training session is recorded and I am notified.
3. You will likely be prompted for a Background Check, so complete that information as well. You will be sent to FastTrax Select, and that site is legitimate for this purpose.
4. Logoff the account ONLY after you select and save the training date and complete the Background Check data.
5. Attend the selected training session, allowing for 90-120 minutes, depending on questions and group size.

\*\*\*TO UPDATE YOUR ACCOUNT AFTER BEING ASKED TO COMPLETE A BACKGROUND CHECK OR SIGN A "CODE OF PASTORAL CONDUCT," make sure you have a recovery email account.




Faith Sharing: Acknowledging God's Gifts and Hearing God's Call
