Cheryl Shockley, is a wife, mother, and grandmother, and a life-long resident of Indianapolis who converted to Catholicism in 1992 and became a secular Carmelite in 1994. Following the loss of her younger son to gun violence in August 2020, Cheryl and her husband founded the Jack Shockley Warriors for Peace, whose mission is to bring peaceful change to the world, one life at a time.

& Forrest Tucker

Forrest Tucker is a Secular Discalced Carmelite who lives with his wife Dawn (46yrs.) in Danville, Indiana They are members of Mary Queen of Peace parish Danville, (43yrs) of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Forrest is a sculptor who works with various elements such as aluminum, steel, stone and glass but mainly works in bronze. Forrest has worked with various metals as a welder/fabricator which includes the casting of bronze, aluminum and steel for 45+years and is a former welder/fabricator for the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, retiring in 2021. Forrest's studies include 6 years with the masters in the steel and stone sculpture department at the Indianapolis Art Center, Lincoln School of Motorsports, Cleveland, Ohio. He holds multiple certificates from a number of institutions and is a violinist in the Adult Strings ensemble at Butler University, Indianapolis.

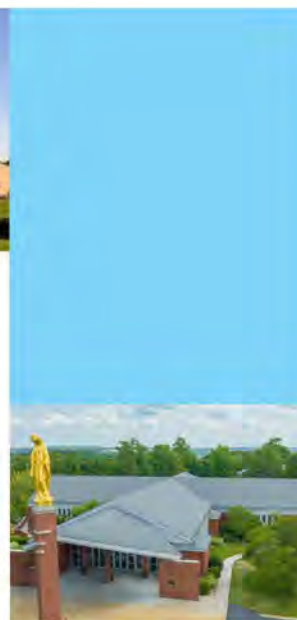

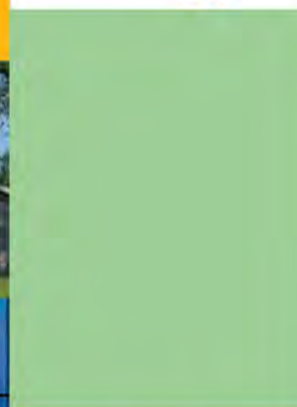

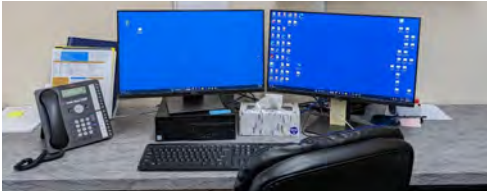
La Fiesta del Inmaculado Corazón de la Santísima Virgen María
