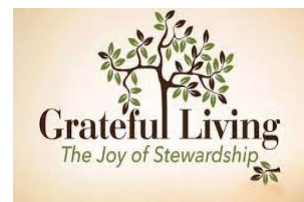
2023 Catholic Stewardship Renewal: New Dates to be Announced Soon

Hope House needs Our Lady of the Lake volunteers to assist at the front register and also around the thrift store.

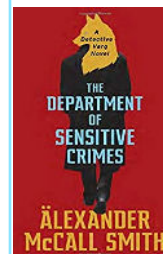

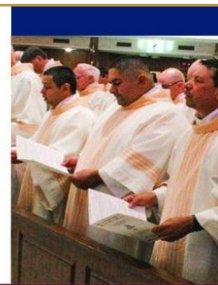

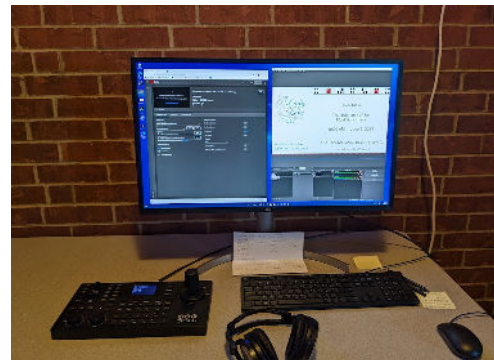
