From the Pastor's Desk:

Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

All of us have been chosen and called to produce fruit in the Kingdom from the vineyard of God. There are many times that people will try to produce fruit for themselves, rather than from God, from God's vineyard. We hear about this in today's gospel (Matthew 21:33-43) as those who were leasing the vineyard from the owner were attempting to produce all for themselves, even to acquiring the property. The work and the production of this work was all about themselves and not about God. They were even so self-centered, jealous and selfish that they killed the owner's son in order to inherit the vineyard for themselves. Working in the vineyard for the glory of God and His kingdom is what we have been called to do. Let us resolve not to be selfish in our efforts or to seek glory for ourselves, but, rather, do all for God and what He has chosen and called us to produce.

DONUTS NEXT SUNDAY

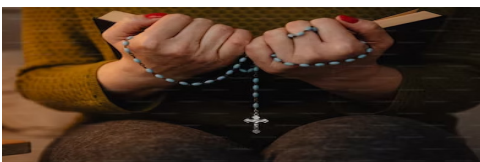
Next Sunday, October 15th there will be donuts, bagels, coffee, juice and milk after the 8:00 and 10:00 Masses.

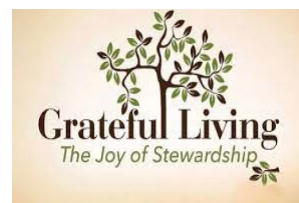

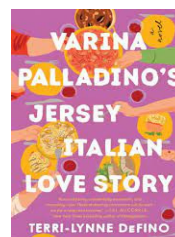

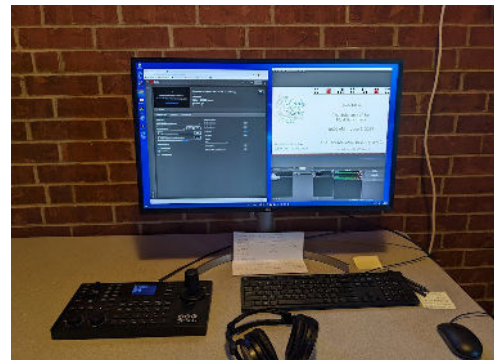
