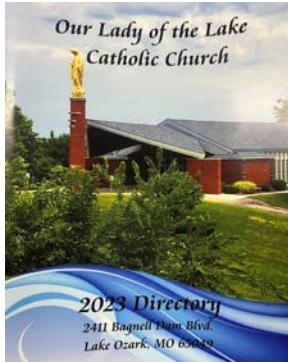

Don't have time for a regular book club? Our quarterly read is for you. We'll meet once to discuss our book and our Lenten journeys.

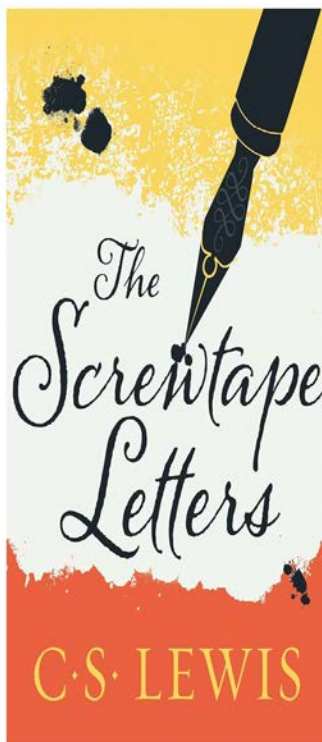
Join us this Lent to discuss CS Lewis' classic, *The Screwtape Letters*!
