PARISHIONER NEWS

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of the Lake Church,

In last week's bulletin a six-month financial statement (July–December 2023) was provided for your information. The first six months of this fiscal year yielded a surplus that the Parish Financial Council had not anticipated. I am making you aware that this surplus will be used for future operating costs and much-needed maintenance of church facilities, and I am providing you with some examples:

Maintenance Expenses

- South entrance steps: repairing and improving the steps leading to the south entrance of the church building. This project has begun, and the estimated cost is fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).
- Stained glass windows: clean and seal the stained-glass windows and replace a broken one in the cry room. The estimated cost is ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000.00), excluding the replacement of the cry room window.
- Parking lot: Fill cracks and other various repairs. The estimated cost is five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).

Future Operating Expenses

To fulfill our parish's particular mission, I anticipate further developmental needs for our Religious Education Program. We have hired a new Religious Education Director but will also need to include for the teachers and students, educational materials, retreat opportunities and pilgrimages. I have increased the office staff for proper and efficient administration, am in the process of locating and hiring a music director for worship and in need of another person to assist in landscaping and custodial work on the parish campus.

I am most grateful for the advice from our Parish Finance Council. These dedicated individuals are committed to their task in assisting me in the administration of the parish goods. Know that all of us are accountable to each of you, but especially to almighty God, in caring for the needs of the parish.

May God bless each of you for your generosity to the parish and may He continue to bless and guide us in our mission in this local community and diocesan Church.

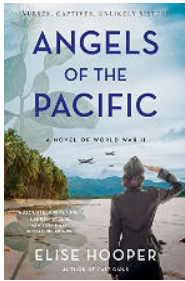

The Jeff Barry Family



This year's proceeds from our Trivia Night go to a young man who grew up in our parish. His dad, Dave, is still a parishioner and his mom, Sue, is his guardian angel. She was one of the co-founders of our Trivia Night event. On November 8, Jeff and his two children were hit by a drunk driver. Miraculously, the children are fine, but unfortunately Jeff was not. He suffered a broken neck and a severe spinal cord injury. He was left paralyzed from the sternum down. Jeff and his wife Rachel are farmers and own Jean's Healthway in Ava. They homeschool their children and are strong community advocates. On December 9, Jeff and his family began their rehab journey at Craig Hospital: Neurorehabilitation Center in Englewood, Colorado. Jeff is making amazing progress, but has a long road ahead of him.

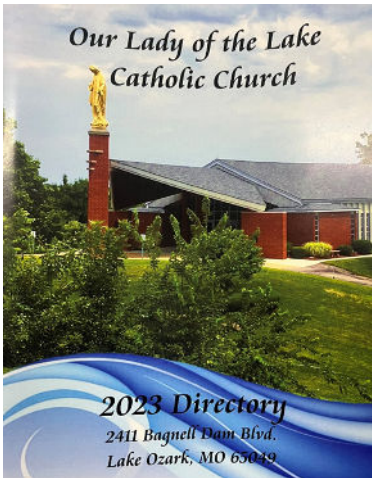
