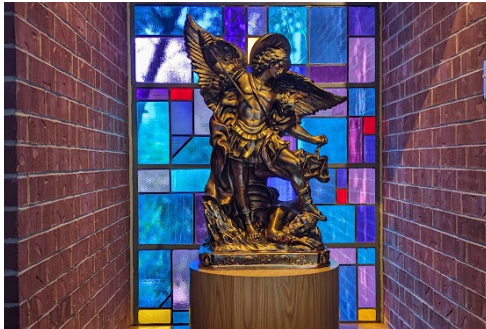

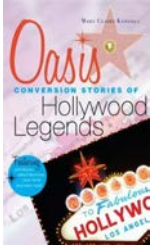

Part 4: Habits of a “Good Steward”

Faith. The journey of a “Good Steward” is often challenged, by our relationships, through our finances, and other demands of this world. Our stewardship journey involves navigating these challenges. We cannot let these challenges push us to sway from the kingdom culture and lose focus of the goal. What do you do when challenges press you on all sides? Hebrews 12:1–2 explains what to do at such times, telling us to keep our gaze on Jesus Christ, the author and finisher of our faith. Without faith, the challenges we face as “Good Stewards” may press in from all sides and weigh us down. Faith is one of the foundations that allows us to live the life of a “Good Steward.” God wants us to trust him for everything, maintaining our faith and trust in his provision.

FAMILY FAITH FORMATION CORNER

(Reflection from Pflaum Gospel Weeklies)

On July 28, the Catholic Church celebrates the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.* In his message on the occasion of this celebration, Pope Francis reflects on the Scripture passage, “Do not cast me off in my old age” (cf. Psalm 71:9). He refers to Jesus’ ancestor Ruth, who remained at the side of her elderly mother-in-law, Naomi, and writes, “by remaining close to the elderly and acknowledging their unique role in the family, in society and in the Church, we will ourselves receive many gifts, many graces, many blessings!”

This week, we can try to follow Ruth’s example and bring some joy and companionship to an elderly person who might be feeling alone or of little value. God does not “cast off” the elderly. May we let them know of God’s love and faithfulness through our own kindness and care for them.

*Note that the U.S. bishops have transferred the celebration of World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly to the first weekend after Labor Day in September. This coincides with National Grandparents (and the Elderly) Day in the United States. Go ahead and celebrate twice!

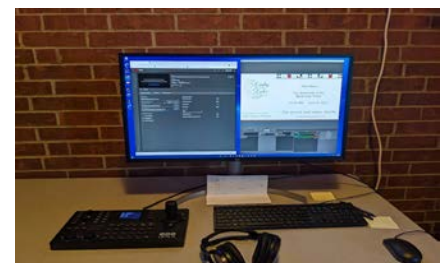

RINCÓN DE FORMACIÓN EN LA FE FAMILIAR

(Reflexión para las lecturas de este domingo de Pflaum Gospel Weeklies)

El 28 de julio, la Iglesia Católica celebra la Jornada Mundial de los Abuelos y de las Personas Mayores.* En su mensaje con motivo de esta celebración, el Papa Francisco reflexiona sobre el pasaje de las Escrituras: "No me deseches en mi vejez" (cf. Salmo 71:9). Se refiere a Rut, la antepasada de Jesús, que permaneció al lado de su anciana suegra, Noemí, y escribe: "al permanecer cerca de los ancianos y reconocer su papel único en la familia, en la sociedad y en la Iglesia, ¡Nosotros mismos recibiremos muchos dones, muchas gracias, muchas bendiciones!"

Esta semana podemos intentar seguir el ejemplo de Rut y brindar algo de alegría y compañía a una persona mayor que tal vez se sienta sola o de poco valor. Dios no "desecha" a los ancianos. Que les hagamos saber del amor y la fidelidad de Dios a través de nuestra propia bondad y cuidado por ellos.

*Tenga en cuenta que los obispos de Estados Unidos han transferido la celebración del Día Mundial de los Abuelos y las Personas Mayores al primer fin de semana después del Día del Trabajo en septiembre. 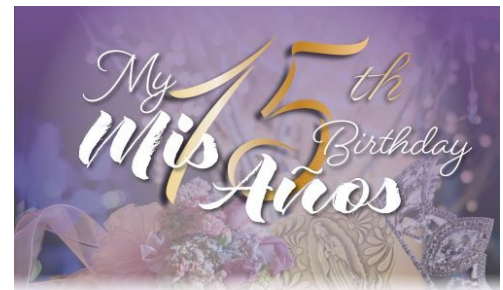
