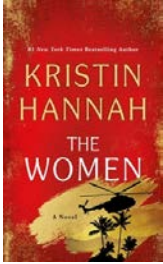

WE ARE CREATED IN GOD'S IMAGE AND LIKENESS

And God said, Let Us make man in Our image,
according to Our likeness...

Gen. 1:26

The starting point of embracing stewardship is really quite simple. We are created in God's image and likeness. Let that sink in for a moment. While we have been taught this fundamental truth, do we really let this truth direct the way in which we live?


We are created in God's image. This primary recognition of who we are immediately calls for gratitude and response. Our very lives are a gift, but more than that, being created in God's image bears with it responsibility. We are called to be the transparency through whom God is seen. We know this through the teaching and example of Jesus Christ. If each of us woke up every morning with the recognition that the day is a gift through which we may make God's love seen and felt by those around us, what a different world this would be. What if each evening as we come to the end of the day, our "examination of conscience" was a simple question: In what way did I, or did I not, make God's love seen and felt today? Stewardship provides a practical way to connect faith with our daily lives. When we grow as stewards, we learn to recognize that we have a need to give — we are created in the image of God who is the giver of all good things. A good steward recognizes that all we are and have are truly God's. We are created in God's image and likeness, as grateful disciples, to be generous as a reflection of the generosity of God.

Family Faith Formation
(Reflection from Pflaum Gospel Weeklies)

“Whoever eats this bread will live forever.” –John 6:51

Real Presence is what the Church calls the reality of Christ in the Eucharist. This isn't artificial presence, the sort we give to people we pretend to listen to while our thoughts are light years away. It's not like the cardboard cutout of Pope Francis you can take a selfie with while the real Pope is back in Rome. Real Presence is the same as Emmanuel, the name for Jesus that means “God with us.” The living bread that came down from Heaven is with us always—until the end of time.

Real Presence is real food. It's not the kind that sustains our bodies for a day, much less the sugar hit that feels good for all of thirty seconds until we're inspired to have another. Real Presence remains through eternity, which is much longer than any companionship we've ever enjoyed. If you're going to stop for a meal, this is one meal you can't afford to miss. Once a week, if not every day, you're invited to be as present to God as God desires to be present to you. Come and see.

“El que come de este pan vivirá para siempre.” -Juan 6:51

La Presencia Real es lo que la Iglesia llama la realidad de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Esta no es una presencia artificial, del tipo que le damos a las personas que pretendemos escuchar mientras nuestros pensamientos están a años luz de distancia. No es como el recorte de cartón del Papa Francisco con el que puedes tomarte una selfie mientras el verdadero Papa está de regreso en Roma. La Presencia Real es lo mismo que Emmanuel, el nombre de Jesús que significa “Dios con nosotros”. El pan vivo que bajó del Cielo está con nosotros siempre, hasta el fin de los tiempos.

La Presencia Real es comida real. No es el tipo que sustenta nuestros cuerpos por un día, mucho menos la dosis de azúcar que se siente bien durante treinta segundos hasta que nos inspiramos a tener otra.
