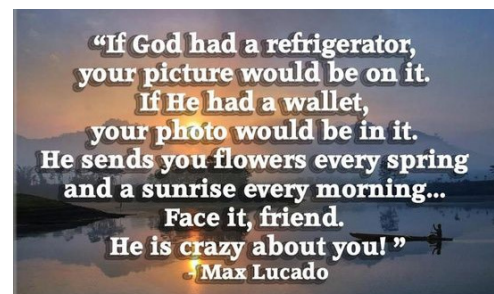
Our Lady of The Lake Education Grants for College Students:
