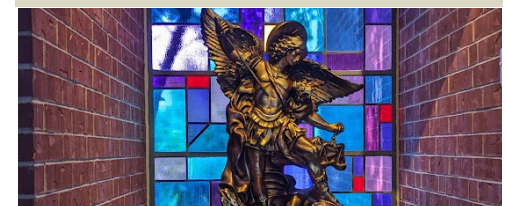

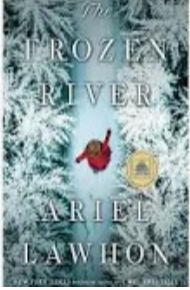

Criteria and applications will be available on the website and in the office on Tuesday, October 8th. They should be turned in by **November 30th**. Grants will be awarded in the second semester.



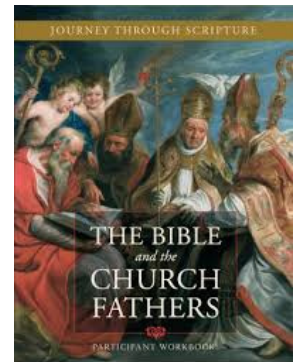
