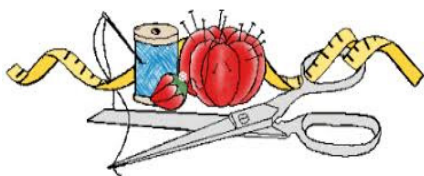
HYMNAL HELP

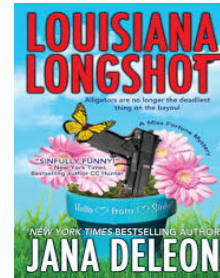

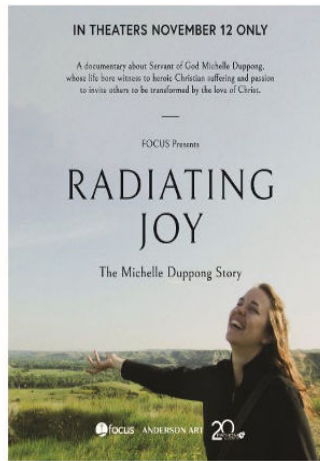
