Advent is a season of awe and wonder. A time to prepare our hearts to celebrate the ultimate gift, the birth of Jesus and His return at the end of time. Our readings for this first week of Advent waste no time calling our urgent attention to the themes of reflection and preparation. How easy it is to lose focus on our Lord. To avoid this, the gospel tells us “be vigilant” and “pray for strength to sustain us.”

Assuredly, during Advent we anticipate the Lord’s coming with hope. It is a hope that encourages our faith in a merciful God who continues to pour His grace upon us. Get ready good stewards! He’s coming! Let us prepare with awe and wonder.

THE SOLEMINTY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION



Decree Dispensing the Faithful from the Obligation to Attend Mass on December 9, 2024

Bishop McKnight has dispensed the faithful in our diocese from the obligation to attend Mass on Monday, Dec. 9. The faithful are still obliged to attend Mass on Sunday, Dec. 8 to celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent.



The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, a holy day of obligation, is typically celebrated on December 8.



This year, the holy day falls on a Sunday. When this happens, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is moved to Monday (Dec. 9).



However, incorrect guidance was widely published and distributed nationally stating that Monday, Dec. 9 is not a holy day of obligation. In addition, there is added difficulty in scheduling a sufficient number of Masses on a regular workday in parishes sharing one priest.



Therefore, the faithful in our diocese are only obliged to attend Mass on Sunday, Dec. 8 to celebrate the Second Sunday of Advent.

Bishop McKnight is asking all priests to offer a Mass in their parishes on Dec. 9 in honor of our national patroness under the title of the Immaculate Conception, even if a Mass is not typically scheduled that day.
