FRIDAY ADORATION



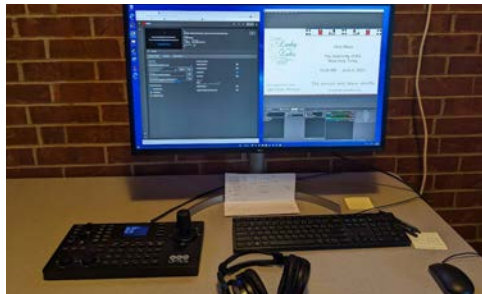
Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available every Friday from 8:30 AM and concludes with Benediction and Reposition at 2:00 PM.

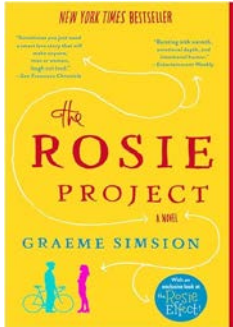

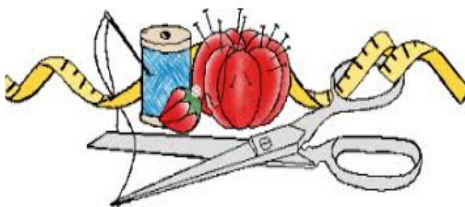

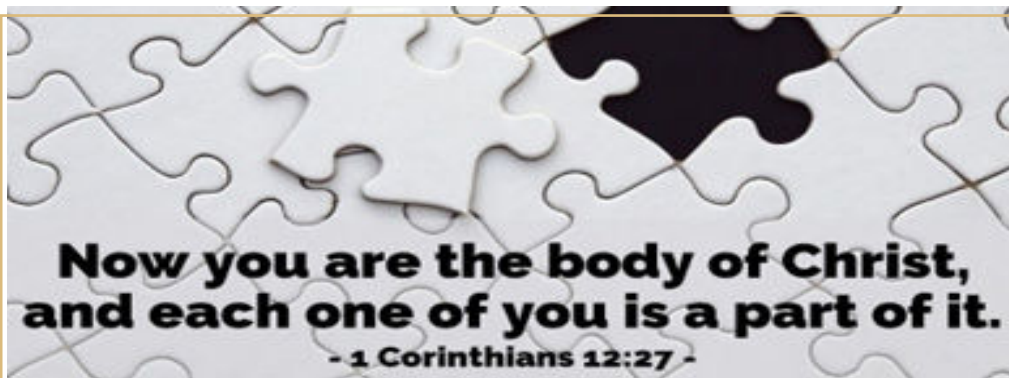
