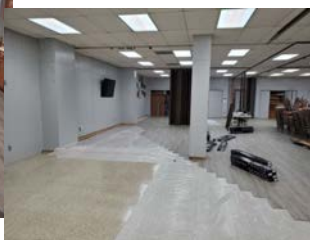
### Parishes As Communities of the Beatitudes A Faith-Sharing Experience

## RINCÓN DE FORMACIÓN EN LA FE FAMILIAR

Es la época del año en la que reflexionamos sobre las formas en las que podemos convertirnos en mejores versiones de nosotros mismos. Podemos considerar comer menos, beber menos, hacer más ejercicio, etc. Pero, ¿qué pasa si este año decidimos trabajar más duro para alcanzar la eternidad con nuestro Señor? Hay tantas pequeñas cosas que uno puede agregar a su rutina que lo acercarán a Dios y a Su promesa de vida eterna con Él. Como padres, es nuestra obligación asegurarnos de criar a nuestros hijos con el conocimiento de que debemos ser como Cristo en nuestro comportamiento y actitud. Aquí hay algunos ejemplos de formas en las que usted y su familia pueden acercarse más a Dios. Planifique asistir a Misa en familia cada semana. Reúnanse como familia y recen el rosario al menos una vez a la semana. Deje que cada miembro de la familia dirija una decena. Sintonicé la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia de Steve Angrisano todos los lunes en Facebook. Él la canta y es hermosa. Considere las Obras Corporales de Misericordia y ponga en práctica una o más durante el año. Recuerden que, a través del bautismo, tenemos la tarea de vivir nuestras vidas de una manera que quienes nos rodean puedan ver la luz de Cristo brillar a través de nosotros. Prometamos todos hacer todo lo posible para permitir que la luz de Cristo brille.

**A continuación, les recordamos las pequeñas cosas que todos podemos hacer para marcar una diferencia en la vida de alguien cada día:**
