PORTA CIMA LOT

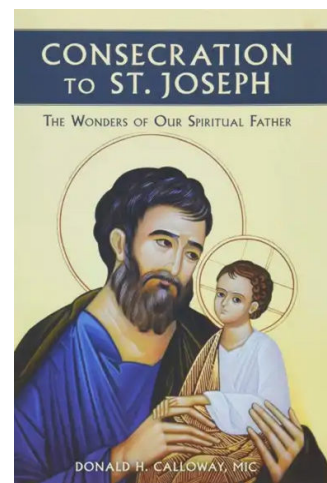
